

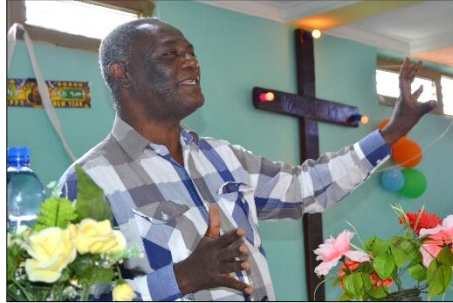

THE CONGREGATION AT HOSANNA IN THEIR NEW BUILDING:



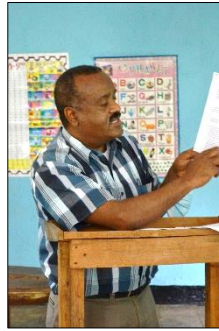
